Retrieve or lose data:

- Ancilla is committed to working with hospitals that migrate their data and who may want to upload at a later date. (Note: There is a fee for those hospitals for data stored by Ancilla later than October 31, 2014.)

Why you don't want your hospital's data deleted:

- Impact on ongoing quality improvement work
- Loss of historical information
- Loss of research data
- Once it is gone, it is gone...

Three options for hospitals that have NOT indicated that they intend to continue using PeriData.Net...

- **Sign up to continue using PeriData.Net[®]** with Ancilla Partners, Inc. (Complete the BAA, UWM/CUPH agreement, and maintenance agreement.)
- If your hospital wants to preserve its data, at a minimum, it must **sign the UWM/CUPH agreement** that releases data to Ancilla to hold for a time. If you are undecided about whether to continue with PeriData.Net[®], this option provides additional time to make a final decision. Ancilla will hold your data for up to one month. After a month, Ancilla will give your hospital the option of migrating to PeriData.Net[®] for a fee, store the data longer for a fee, or delete the data.
- If your hospital is no longer interested in retrieving the data held at UWM/CUPH, you do not need to do anything. **Your hospital's data will be deleted on September 19, 2014.**

Preserving logic for Custom Reports

- **How to ensure my custom reports' logic and layout are saved prior to the transition.**
- Many hospitals have created custom reports that they would like to re-create after the transition to the new system.
- Each hospital will need to capture each SELECTED custom report's logic and layout.

General Tips

- Note – You will not have to save the CheckPoint or Elective Delivery Reports. Ancilla will handle these.
- Contact Allen at Ancilla for additional questions (allen@ancillapartners.com)
- Allow time to rebuild custom reports after migration. The amount of time needed will depend on the number of reports, the level of complexity, and ease of adaptation to Pentaho.

Migration process and SVRIS

- UWM stops receiving data from SVRIS on 9/19 in the evening
- SVRIS continues to store hospital data
- 9/22, the data flows from SVRIS to Ancilla
- Hospitals must have the SVRIS agreement fully executed
- Ancilla will communicate the exact time UWM stops and Ancilla begins receiving SVRIS data
- Ancilla and WAPC will communicate continuously with hospitals throughout the migration process.

All agreements must be fully executed!

- UWM data transmission agreement
- Business Associate Agreement (BAA)
- Maintenance agreement
- SVRIS agreement
