

WAPC Board of Directors Nominations Due October 1, 2018

The WAPC Nominating Committee is seeking candidates for president-elect, consumer or other member-at-large, and regional representatives to the Board. President-Elect & Consumer or Other Member-At-Large

Each year the WAPC Nominating Committee reviews nominations for President –Elect and Consumer or Other Member-At-Large and submits its recommendations to the WAPC Board of Directors at its fall meeting. After approval by the Board, the nominees are placed on an electronic ballot and the WAPC membership votes in January.

The *President-Elect* must be familiar with the organization and activities of WAPC. Ideally, the nominee has served on the WAPC Board of Directors. For additional guidance in making nominations, [click here](#). The presidential position is a three-year commitment beginning immediately following the 2019 annual conference. The commitment begins by serving as president-elect for one year and then transitioning into the president and immediate past president positions in the successive two years ending in April 2022 at the conclusion of the 2022 WAPC annual conference.

The *Consumer or Other Member-At-Large* position is for an individual who is not and has not been a health professional and is over eighteen (18) years of age.

Regional Representatives to the Board

There are three representatives (physician, nurse, and allied health) to the WAPC Board from each of the seven WAPC regions. The terms of office are staggered among the three representatives. The Regional Chairs are responsible for identifying those interested in board representation and for contacting incumbents to determine their intent to run. The Regional Chairs send the list of nominees to the WAPC Nominating Committee. The nominees are placed on an electronic ballot and the respective WAPC regional membership votes in January. Below is a list of regional positions available in 2019.

Regional Positions Available in 2019:

Fox Valley Region – Nurse Representative

Northcentral Region – Physician Representative

Northeast Region – Nurse Representative

Northwest Region – Physician, Nurse, and Allied Health Representatives

Southcentral Region – Allied Health Representative

Southeast Region – Allied Health Representative

Western Region – Physician Representative

The Board of Directors meets twice a year—once during the annual conference and once in late fall. The term of office for regional representatives and consumer or other member-at-large is three years beginning immediately following the 2019 Annual Conference and ending in April 2022 at the conclusion of the annual conference.

All members are welcome to nominate anyone who is interested in any of the available positions and to self-nominate. If individuals under consideration are not members, they must become members to be nominated.
